## EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

“The courage and strength that are in me are not of me, but of him who lives in me. It is the Eucharist.” (St. Faustina)  
Every Wednesday evening, St. Patrick’s parish has the grace of Holy Mass at 6:30 pm, followed by a period of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament until 8:00 pm. But what is Adoration? It is the beautiful practice of praying before the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, placed in a Monstrance on the altar. It is a privileged opportunity to deepen our relationship with Christ, to share intimately with Him in loving awareness and conversation, to present our needs to Him with trust, to grow in faith, hope and love, to be strengthened and renewed in grace, to *be still* and know God’s unfailing love. The saints all agree. “The best time you will spend on earth is the time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.” (St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta). “Visit the Lord in that *heart to heart* contact that is Eucharistic Adoration. Day after day you will receive new energy to bring comfort to the suffering and peace to the world.” (Pope St. John Paul II). As Lent approaches, consider attending Wednesday Mass and Adoration each week. You will receive all that you need—and more—from the God who loves you with an infinite love!

## SOUP AND STATIONS

Lent is almost here! We are continuing our Tuesday practice of serving a “soup supper” (from 5:00 – 5:45 pm) followed by some time for prayer and Stations of the Cross at 6:00 pm. This year, we will be asking different parish groups to prepare and lead the Stations. We hope that some groups who are leading Stations might also be willing to make one or more of the soups for that evening! Sign up papers will be posted through the week on the back Bulletin Board. On the first Tuesday of Lent, there will be an opportunity for a spiritual reflection on the meaning of the Stations of the Cross given at 5:30 pm. (before Stations).
