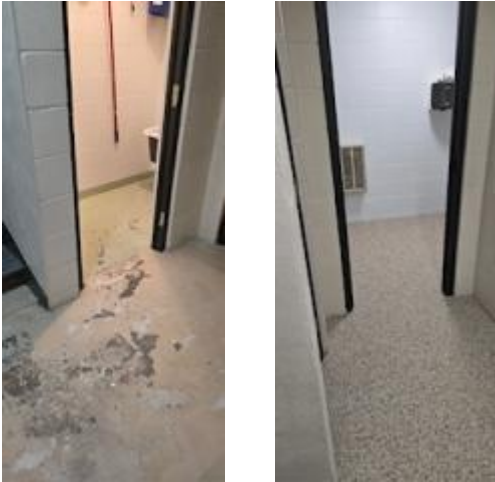

### **The Solemnity of the Assumption**

As the month of August begins, we turn our attention to the celebration of the Blessed Mother's entrance into heavenly glory. The *Catechism* explains that Mary "was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of His Body." (CCC, 974) This feast reminds us of

our life's ultimate destination: eternal life in the glory of heaven! Throughout her life, the Blessed Mother continually chose to go deeper into her relationship with God. Her "yes" to God's will, no matter what the cost, led her to the fulfillment of her mission here on earth. We all have a mission. And when it is completed here on earth, we, too are called into our "forever life" with the God who created us, loves us and continues to call us deeper into our destiny. For Mary, the Assumption was her beautiful reunion—with Jesus, St. Joseph, Sts Anna and Joachim and all those she loved who had gone before her in faith.
