HOLIEST WEEK OF THE YEAR

We have begun the holiest week of the year! It stands at the head of our calendar as we celebrate the “high holy days” of our Catholic faith. In fact, the participation of the faithful in the solemn and beautiful Holy Week Liturgies, reveals something of the strength and vitality of a parish’s worship. It is important for all of us to prioritize coming to Church on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter to share in the richness of our Salvation. We have the added blessing of all of these Liturgies being scheduled here in our home parish!

THIRTEENTH STATION: COME – AND PRAY!

(As we enter Holy Week, pause and enter into the Passion of Christ with Mary. Reflect on our church’s beautiful, sacred image of the Passion).



In this Station, commonly called “The Pieta” we see the Precious Body of Jesus returned to the arms of his Mother Mary. It was she who had held Him in her arms as an Infant. Now, His mission fulfilled, He is returned to her. For burial. She holds His arms out in a gesture of openness. His arms, wide open, embrace the whole world. She shows us the depth of His Love in this Station as she holds the arms of Jesus open in an embrace of ultimate sacrifice. Jesus, her Son and our Savior, gave everything. He paid the price for our salvation. How deeply she shared in that pain. Let this Station remind us to offer comfort and compassion to those who suffer and together, to find hope in God’s promise of the Resurrection.

Prayer: O Mary, Mother of Sorrows, we turn to you as we embark on this holiest week of the year. Simeon had foretold that your heart would be pierced. And it was. “Let me share with you His pain, who for all my sins was slain; who for me in torment died.” (Words taken from the hymn *Stabat Mater*). As we share in your sorrow, O Mary, may we also share in your hope for the Resurrection!
