Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

January 18-25, 2026 is the annual observance of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Begun in 1908, this ecumenical initiative is celebrated each year in cities and towns across the country and world. The theme selected for this year is from Ephesians 4:4 *“There is one body and one spirit, just as you are called to the one hope of your calling.”* This theme reflects Pope Leo XIV’s hope of a unified humanity in an increasingly individualistic world. In the resource materials published for this week by the Vatican, we read that unity is “more than simply an ideal, but a divine mandate at the core of our Christian identity...It represents the essence of the Church’s calling—a call to reflect the harmonious oneness of our life in Christ amidst our diversity. This divine unity is central to our mission and is sustained by the profound love of Jesus Christ, who has set before us a unified purpose.”
