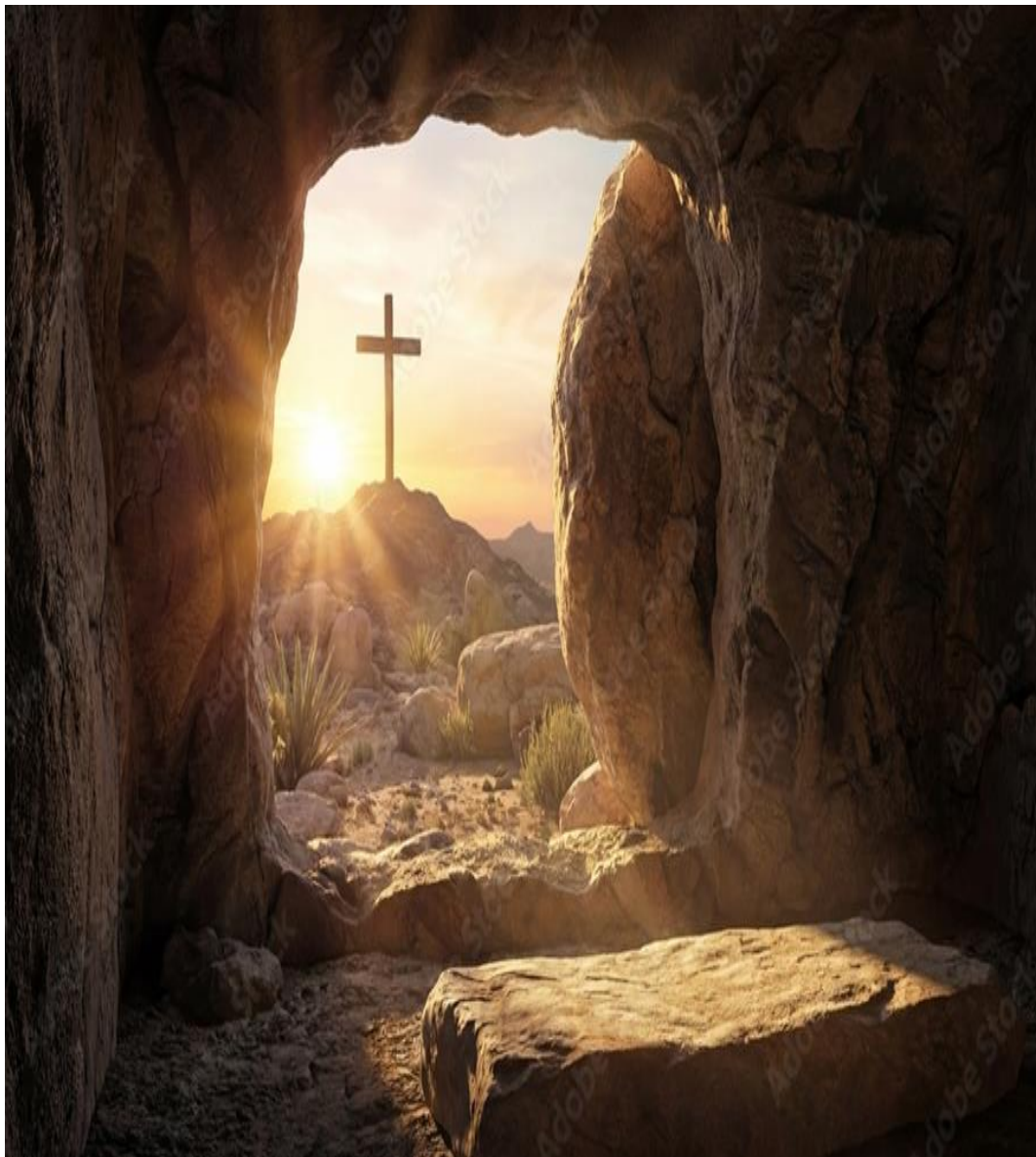

Father Jason is a priest of the Society of the Catholic Apostolate, commonly known as the Pallottines. Father Jason was ordained a priest of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Province in Bangalore, India on May 5, 2016. He went on mission to the United States and he arrived in the Diocese of Toledo in September 2022, becoming associate pastor of St. Mary and St. John parishes in Defiance. He has served as associate pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Sylvania since July 2025 and he begins his time with us here in Delphos, Landeck, and Spencerville this summer. We look forward to welcoming Fr. Jason to our parish families.
