THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

The solemnity we celebrate today is the central mystery of the Catholic faith: the doctrine of the Blessed Trinity. There is one God in three Divine, co-equal, co-eternal persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. This is a deep mystery. The Catechism of the Catholic Church emphasizes that “the Trinity is a mystery of faith that surpasses human understanding but is revealed by God and entrusted to the Church.” Jesus commanded the apostles to “Baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we give glory to the Blessed Trinity. Between each decade of the Rosary and at the conclusion of each psalm in the Divine Office, a “Glory Be” is prayed. Let us today renew our praise to our God: Creator, Redeemer and Sanctifier as we sing: “Praise to God forever be, One in life, in Persons three: Mighty God, Saving God, God eternal Trinity!”

June 29 – Landeck VBS – pre-K through Grade 5. Registration flyers in back of church.



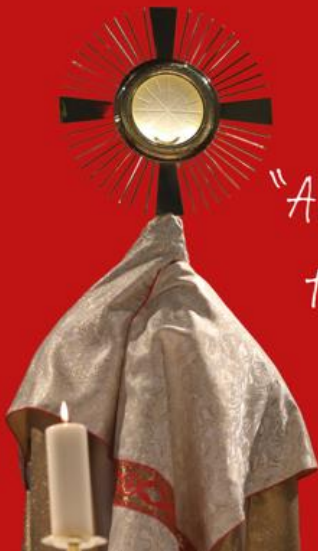
LANDECK VOCATION BIBLE SCHOOL FOR PRE-SCHOOL – GRADE 5
