#### **History of OUR Local Parishes**



In early 1867, Fr. Frances Westerholt made monthly trips from Delphos to the Catholics of Van Wert. A mission was established and served by the pastors of Delphos. Until 1869, a room

at the home of Peter Roach was used for mass. In July 1869, Fr. Hoeffel purchased two lots facing South Chestnut Street. There was a small house on one of the lots, which was converted into a chapel. In the summer of 1874, work was begun on a brick church. Volunteers from Van Wert and from St. John's in Delphos hauled the donated stone for the foundation of the new church. The new St. Mary's Church, costing \$4,000, was dedicated in 1876. St. Mary's continued to be a mission church until December of 1876 when the Bishop of Cleveland appointed Fr. J. H. Leddy as the first resident pastor. In 1957, ground was bought on Jennings Rd. for a new school and church. The new church was dedicated in May of 1965.

Fr. Brem of Landeck would also occasionally travel to Van Wert to say Mass, making Van Wert a daughter parish of Landeck. ~Written by Jack Bockey
