

Parishioners, Teens, and Young Adults of St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick.

My name is Wendy Gerstner and I am serving as the high school and young adult minister at St. John's in Delphos. I began working there in June. My husband, Ron and I have been together for 25 years and have 6 kids and 1 grandson. I have worked in ministry for 24 years now. I love watching what God does in the lives of teens and young adults and their families. Fr. Dennis was hoping that we could develop some opportunities within the 3 parishes that our teens and young adults could attend together going forward.

I have had the privilege of having coffee and getting to know Gina Clement, youth minister at St. Patrick's. I have spoken with Sister Immacolata on her wishes for the students at these parishes along with your newest pastor Fr. Jeff. I am excited to see where the Lord leads our teens and young adults!

Here are some wonderful opportunities we have currently.

Our 1st large trip will be in January, to attend the annual March for Life in DC. Currently we have 26 high school teens signed up! This is a 3-day trip where the youth will be attending Mass, touring the National Basilica, the Monastery of the Holy Land, attending the Sisters for Life Event, and marching with tens of thousands from every faith, race, and age, in order to protect life from its tiniest start through its natural God given end. Payments to the bussing company are due in December.

Second on our list is Covecrest Life Teen Camp in Tiger Georgia! Father Dennis had this as a vision last year; however, we just couldn't squeeze it in with me just being hired. We will be taking a 12 passenger van. Students will enjoy 5 days of growth in their spiritual lives with Mass, Adoration, witness talks, and journaling. They will also have amazing activities including team building events, mud run, music, high ropes, games, and white water rafting!! AND our own Fr. Jeff will be there with us!!! This trip is in June; however, deposits are due ASAP. I only have 5 spots left.

Our 3rd event is the Steubenville Youth Conference at Franciscan University in July. Students will experience dorm life with 2000 other teens from across the country for 2.5 days of amazing Catholic speakers and powerful witness talks. They will celebrate the sacraments each day and a live house band all weekend. I have 14 spots for this trip and deposits are due February 3rd.
