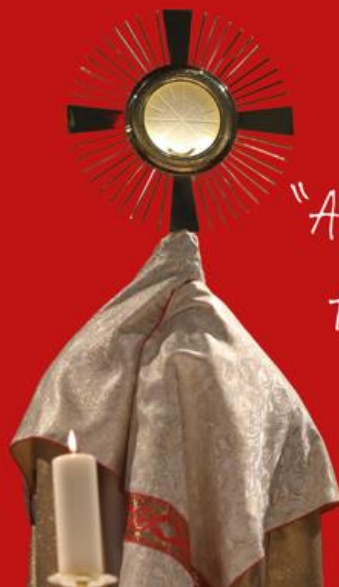
MEMORIAL DAY MASS AT LANDECK CEMETERY
