

### **Our Parish History**

When St. Patrick parish was established in 1858 by Bishop Rappe, it was a mission of Delphos. The new parish acquired 1 1/2 acres of land in



1858 although it was not recorded until 1884. In 1860, a log church 16 by 36 feet was built. In 1868, the parish became a mission of the newly formed Landeck parish. In 1876, a frame church 36 by 60 was built with a cost of \$1200. —Written by Jack Bockey


