It will take place at 8:30 p.m. and includes the lighting of the Easter Fire outdoors, the Procession with the Paschal Candle (Light of Christ) into the church, the singing of the glorious Exultet, the reading of the story of our Salvation, Solemn Intercessions and the reintroduction of the Gloria and ALLELUIA into Holy Mass. It is a spiritual experience that you won't want to miss.

Our Parish History

When St. Patrick parish was established in 1858 by Bishop Rappe, it was a mission of Delphos. The new parish acquired 1 1/2 acres of land in



1858 although it was not recorded until 1884. In 1860, a log church 16 by 36 feet was built. In 1868, the parish became a mission of the newly formed Landeck parish. In 1876, a frame church 36 by 60 was built with a cost of \$1200. ~Written by Jack Bockey
