ST. PATRICK'S PARISH WELCOMES FR. JASON D'SOUZA

This past Wednesday, our new Pastoral Associate, Father Jason D'Souza offered Holy Mass at St. Patrick's. Several of our parishioners were there to meet and welcome Father at the door and present him with a plant, a token of gratitude for his presence here. Father Jason is a Pallottine priest, originally from Bangalore, India. In India, he served as an Associate Pastor for a year and then taught in the seminary for three years, after which he was asked to come to the United States. He arrived in the fall of 2022 to serve in the Diocese of Toledo. Prior to coming here, Father Jason served as the Parochial Vicar at St. Joseph Parish in Sylvania, where he celebrated his 10th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood this past May. Father is the second oldest of four siblings. His parents were Catholic farmers in India. The Pallottine Fathers and Brothers, of which Father Jason is a member, were founded in 1835 by St. Vincent Pallotti in Rome. Dedicated to the motto "The Charity of Christ urges us on" they focus on reviving faith, rekindling charity and collaborating with the laity. We are very happy to have Father Jason as one of our priests and look forward to getting to know him!
