

#### **Sisters Away for Community Celebrations**

Sister Immacolata and Sister Mary Edward will be away from Tuesday, August 13 until Wednesday, August 28. They are attending their annual community days of celebration at the motherhouse in New Jersey. Three Sisters will make final vows and two others renew their vows, while twenty Sisters will celebrate Jubilees. Sister Mary Edward will be flying to Germany on August 18. She was asked to play the organ for the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Mass of the Sisters of Christian Charity, at the actual site of the founding, the Busdorfkirche, in Paderborn.

# Sisters of Christian Charity Celebrate 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Founding

On August 21, the Sisters of Christian Charity (SCCs) celebrated their Founding in 1849 by Blessed Pauline von Mallinckrodt, a "Woman Who Couldn't Be Stopped," as one of her biographers described her. Mother Pauline had a vision and mission which is as attractive today as it was in her own time, (1817-1881). In fact, at her Beatification on April 14, 1985, St. Pope John Paul II said in his homily that her spirituality is even more relevant today than yesterday! Pauline had an unbounded love for the poor (and all people of every nation, race, age, social condition) and her courage, joyous enthusiasm and energy had as its source "a deep and intimate union with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament." She and three companions, the first Sisters of Christian Charity, responded to God's call to become a new religious community in the Church, 175 years ago, in Paderborn, Germany. Almost immediately, many others joined them in their vowed consecration and active, apostolic life, which flourished throughout Germany in many different cities and towns. Then, in the 1860s when Otto von Bismarck rose to power, a persecution of the Church began to rage there. Religious property was seized and all the schools were closed by the government. The Sisters had to leave their cherished missions. At the same time requests from North and South America came pouring in for Sisters to teach the German immigrant children. Pauline responded. At the time of her death there were already 27 establishments in the USA, 8 in Chile and 8 in Europe. Today, the Sisters in the USA serve in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, New York, Ohio, West Virginia and Chicago. Also in Germany, Chile, Uruguay, Argentina and the Philippines. All the SCCs throughout the world will be celebrating this week as they thank God for their foundress, Blessed Pauline, and all those who have followed in her footsteps. Among them will be Sister Immacolata and Sister Mary Edward, who strive to live her spirit here in NW Ohio.
